I also authorize the use of such anesthetics as you deem advisable in the performance of such surgical, diagnostic, or therapeutic procedures. I realize that the administration of any anesthetic agent carries a small but realistic possibility of side effects which may include death.

I recognize the nature of the surgical procedure(s) being performed and realize that certain risks and complications may be involved. I acknowledge that no guarantee or assurance has been made as to the results that may be obtained.

Advances in anesthesia have made routine procedures relatively safe, with low rates of complications. However, occasional problems can occur due to pre-existing conditions not evident during routine histories and physical examinations. To minimize problems, we recommend that your pet be screened prior to surgery by means of one or more of the diagnostic tests described below.

<input type="checkbox"/>	IDEXX Lasercyte CBC (Complete Blood Count). This is a hematology test that provides measurements of red blood cells, white blood cells, and platelets. The CBC is an important tool that can indicate anemia, leukemia, stress, inflammation, infection, and blood clotting capabilities.	\$35.00
<input type="checkbox"/>	IDEXX GHP (17-Point Chemistry Panel). This profile helps diagnose problems associated with the kidneys, liver, gastrointestinal system, endocrine system, and metabolic disorders.	\$91.10
<input type="checkbox"/>	CBC and 17-Point Chemistry Panel (Total Health Profile). <u>Recommended for all routine surgeries on young, healthy cats and dogs.</u>	\$136.00
<input type="checkbox"/>	Total Health Plus Profile. Includes CBC, 17-point chemistry, and thyroid test. <u>Recommended for senior cats and dogs.</u>	\$180.00

Includes CBC, 17-point chemistry, thyroid test, electrolyte panel, and Heartworm Test for dogs, or Feline Leukemia/Feline Immunodeficiency Virus Test for cats. <u>Recommended for dogs older than 6 years that have not been on yearly heartworm prevention, or for cats older than 6 years that have not been tested for Feline Leukemia or Feline Immunodeficiency Virus.</u>	Dogs: \$216.00 Cats: \$226.00

Putting in an intravenous catheter and maintaining your animal on I.V. fluids during surgery has many benefits. Having an I.V. catheter in place can allow the veterinarian to immediately give medications into the bloodstream should an emergency develop. In addition, keeping your pet on fluids during surgery helps keep the blood pressure from dropping which can have a negative impact on many of the body's internal organs as well as prolong recovery from anesthesia. **This procedure is optional for a fee of \$66.00.**

We are excited to have the latest technology at Lyons Veterinary Clinic. We have recently upgraded and are offering the usage of Laser Surgery. Using a surgical laser in place of a scalpel blade will decrease pain, decrease blood loss during surgery, decrease swelling, and provide a quicker healing time. **The use of the laser may be required for the surgery that your pet is here for (i.e. cat declaws); however, it is optional for spays and neuters. Your pet can be provided with this more comfortable option for an additional fee of \$32.00.**

I **DECLINE** the use of the Surgical Laser. *This is required for cat declaws.*

I **ACCEPT** the use of the Surgical Laser.

The use of Laser Therapy has been shown to dramatically help decrease pain and inflammation as well as increase oxygenation and blood flow to damaged cells. It is our recommendation to have Laser Therapy Treatment applied to your pet's incision(s) immediately post-op. **This procedure is optional for a fee of \$10.00.**

I **DECLINE** the use of Laser Therapy Treatment over the incision(s).

I **ACCEPT** the use of Laser Therapy Treatment over the incision(s).

I realize that I agree to hold Lyons Veterinary Clinic harmless, in the absence of negligence, in the event of untoward anesthetic complications that might have been detected had these tests been performed and/or slow or extended recovery time that may have been prevented had pain medications and/or laser therapy been given.
